RABQSA-RES - Resilience Management Systems Auditing (Security, Preparedness, Crisis, Continuity, and Recovery Management)

Managing the risks of disruptive events is critical to the survival and competitiveness of any organization. The ASIS International Resilience Lead Auditor Certification will help you assess organizational and supply chain risks, maintain and improve resilience management systems, and successfully conduct resilience management system audits. The RABQSA certified training program supports standards that address the management of risk related to events that may disrupt an organization's operations. The RABQSA-RES Competency Unit covers the requirements of resilience standards (e.g., ANSI/ASIS.SPC.1: 2009; ISO 28002:2011; DS 3001:2009; or NEN 7131:2010), as well as discipline specific standards in business continuity management (e.g. ANSI/ASIS/BSI BCM.1:2010; BSI 25999:2007; or ISO/FDIS 22301), and security management (e.g. ISO 28000:2007, ASIS/WD.PAP.1). The course seamlessly integrates with the ISO 31000 Risk Management standard to allow organizations to develop a cost-effective, holistic approach to managing risk.

This program is designed for those responsible for planning, implementing, managing, and auditing resilience management systems and who have worked in security, crisis, continuity, or risk management roles including asset protection, loss prevention, IT and electronic systems, emergency and incident response and recovery, personnel protection, and transport and logistics.

SESSION TOPICS INCLUDE:

- Planning, managing, conducting, and reporting 1st, 2nd, and 3rd-party audits according to ISO 19011 and ISO 17021; and examining relevant case studies.
- Developing a comprehensive risk management strategy according to the ISO 31000:2009 Risk Management standard.
- Understanding the resilience, security, and business continuity management system standards requirements from an auditor's perspective.
- Assessing and managing the risks of events that can potentially disrupt an organization and its supply chain.
- Principles and concepts of management system implementation for integrating risk and resilience management into all aspects of the organization.
- Identifying and understanding the organizational and supply chain context of an organization, including its interdependencies.
- Structure and make-up of management system documentation.
- Roles and responsibilities for resilience, security, and continuity management.
- Performance evaluation and corrective actions to drive continual improvement.

Successful completion of this course provides evidence that participants have been assessed as being competent in RABQSA-AU (Management Systems Auditing), RABQSA-TL (Leading Management System Audit Teams), and RABQSA-RES – Resilience Management Systems Auditing (Security, Preparedness, Crisis, Continuity, and Recovery Management). Participants will also be eligible to apply for Provisional Registration from RABQSA, a requirement for international recognition as a RABQSA Certified Lead Auditor.
