As you know, ASIS is comprised of 34,000 global security practitioner members who join for access to global networking, world class content, and the opportunity to network with their peers. Woven into the fabric of ASIS International's structure is a strong chapter network that in different parts of the world have varying structures and sizes. In the case of Spain, the Chapter represents the whole of the country.

Over the past few months, it has come to the attention of ASIS International Headquarters that there are concerns among the Spain Chapter membership regarding Chapter related issues that are cause for concern. Our volunteers and HQ staff team have worked very hard to determine a course of action for the Spain Chapter that is representative of the ASIS culture; one that celebrates and fosters inclusion, transparency, and full member support.

Unfortunately, we have come to a place in time where we find we must take action to ensure a new future for ASIS members in Spain. As such the ASIS Global Board of Directors voted unanimously to revoke the current Spain Chapter (#143) Charter that ASIS International issued in 1981. Please know that we had hoped to avoid taking this step but feel it is in your best interest as an ASIS Spain Chapter member, and our best interest, to take this action at this time. I do not communicate this to you lightly, rather, with a heavy heart. As such, any decisions taken by ASIS Spain Chapter as of today will not be recognized by ASIS International.

While it is our intention to form a new Chapter at some point in the future, there are some very important things for you to know, including:

1. Your ASIS International membership and all your membership benefits continue as usual.
2. We are providing you with the opportunity to access an online community where you can network with colleagues from Spain while we oversee the transition. Our Headquarters Team will be in touch shortly with more details about how to access this community.
3. If you would like to associate with another Chapter within the ASIS community, that is also an option.
